Aberconwy students and staff celebrated the school's best ever A level results with A/A\* grades (or their equivalent) making up **30% of all results** and **66% of the year group** celebrating at least one A grade.

Exceptional results were achieved by Rebecca Caulfield (A\*, A, A), Ieuan Hennessy (A\*, A\*, A, B), Josh Hunt (A\*, A, A, B) and Matthew Williams (A\*, A\*, A\*, A, C). 95% of students have been

accepted by their first University choice and are set to start a variety of degree courses including Italian and Linguistics at Bangor, Mechanical Engineering at Bath and Aerospace Engineering at Swansea. As a school we are very proud of an exceptional group of young people who have achieved their potential and who are now moving on to study interesting and challenging courses. Well done to all our sixth form students who organised the Macmillan Coffee Morning at the end of September - raising well over £200 for such a worthy cause.



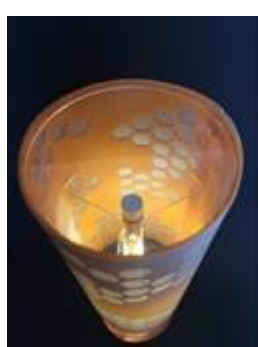

## Language Learning

We have weekly languages clubs for German and French respectively on Wednesday and Thursday lunchtimes. These are led by the Language Ambassadors who have introduced new language to the lower school, played games, run competitions and created a video based on a parody of 'Under The Sea' from the Little Mermaid to help remember certain grammar rules in German. The Language Ambassadors also delivered assemblies to the whole school about the European Day of Languages in September.

GCSE linguists entered a League of Champions online competition for the European Day of Languages in which over 640 schools across the globe took part. Sadly we did not come in the top 20, however there were a number of fantastic individual performances from Denise Yesil, a dual linguist, who has been named the 'school genius' in both French and Spanish, and Anthony North 'school genius' for German.



We have just started working with a new Foreign Language Assistant. Bernadette Pinzer, an Erasmus student at Bangor university from Innsbruck in Austria, who will be working with GCSE and A level German pupils. This is a great opportunity for our students to help develop and build confidence in their speaking skills with a native German speaker.

Year 9 have been learning to talk about aches and pains using blow-up skeletons and assessing each others language through role-plays at the doctors and at the recent Open Evening we offered a taste of the languages on offer at YAC through continental food tasting which was a success with the parents and pupils who came to visit the department.

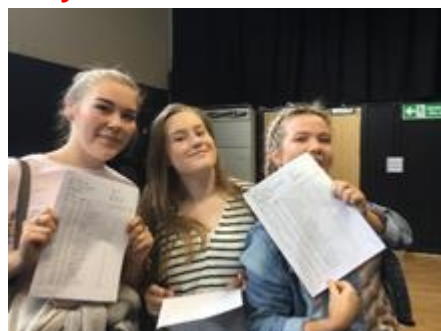

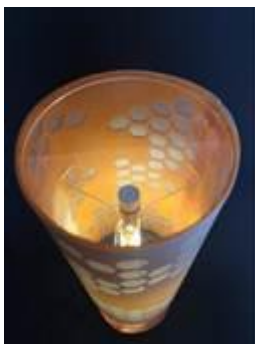
