But do you know what your child can access on their Smartphone? If your child has an iPhone did you know about the parental control feature? There is also a similar feature for Android phones too.

iPhone parental control feature...

- Click settings
- General
- Restrictions
- Enable Restrictions
- Set a passcode
- Select the areas you wish to restrict



Protect personal information...

Smartphones have access to lots of personal information for example photos, videos and automatic logins set up for email, social networking sites such as Facebook and also most importantly bank accounts.

Do all phones in your household have a passcode set, to control who accesses the information stored on a Smartphone?
