Revision techniques

Then for each topic, work through the following steps until you can correctly answer the questions.

1. Look at the specification and make **1 page of summary revision notes** on each point/concept using exercise books and revision guides.
2. **Attempt questions** (exam papers/packs/bitesize/any others you can find)
3. **Mark questions and correct any you got wrong.**
4. Any incorrect get **added to revision notes** in the form of a fact or model answer. – seek help if you don't know where the answer came from!
5. **Repeat** until ALL questions are correct.
6. **Simplify** revision notes over time removing content you know leaving behind what you still need to work on.
