Internet - Each student has the use of a 'knowitallninja' account that is specifically designed as a learning tool for the unit 1 theory exam. Each topic includes an animation, video and written summary for each topic. At the end of each topic there is a quiz which we complete in class. The topics can be accessed at home to look at again for revision.

Revision techniques



- Avoid leaving all your revision to the last minute, spend about 30 minutes each week going through the topic(s) covered in lessons.
- Use the knowitallninja and the Intranet revision guide to revise and reinforce the topics again.
- Nearer to the exam, complete the past paper questions that you are given to the best of your ability and take note of any comments, feedback and corrections made to avoid making the same mistakes again.
- ASK if you are unsure about a topic.
- The day before the exam get some sleep, do not stay up all night revising.
- Always look at the amount of marks given for each question as this will help to know how much detail is required for the answer.
- Putting all your effort in first time around will help save the time and hassle of doing a resit.
