Revision techniques

Little and often = successful language learning. Try to develop good learning habits.

1. Make sure you know your vocabulary. Use the recommended websites.
2. Challenge yourself to 10 new words per week. Get your parents to test you. Teach them to your parents and test them!
3. Know what is in your exercise book. Spend time reading over what you have done in class and question anything you are unsure of.
4. Listen to French/German radio to 'tune in' to the language. You won't understand everything but you will start to develop an ear for your language. Similarly, listen to French/German artists on YouTube.
