Arolwg Rhieni - Adborth

Diolch i'n holl rieni a ymatebodd i'r arolwg diweddar yn gofyn am eich barn ar nifer o bynciau yn yr ysgol, ac i bawb a roddodd eu cyfeiriadau e-bost hefyd i drefnu trafodaethau dilynol.

Derbyniwyd 235 o ymatebion ac rydym wedi rhannu'r holl wybodaeth oedd ynddynt gyda'r corff llywodraethu. Rydym yn falch o weld ymatebion mor gadarnhaol, ond rydym hefyd wedi myfyrio ar rai meysydd yr ydych wedi'u nodi i ni weithio arnynt yn y tymor newydd.

Yn fyr, canfuwyd y canlynol:

- Dywedodd 90% o rieni bod eu plant yn hoffi'r ysgol o leiaf 'peth o'r amser', gyda 63% yn ymateb o leiaf 'y rhan fwyaf o'r amser'.
- Teimlai 85% o rieni fod yr ysgol wedi helpu eu plant i ymgartrefu'n dda pan ddechreuasant yn yr ysgol.
- Teimlai 86% fod eu plant yn ddiogel yn yr ysgol.
- Roedd 62% (o'r rhai a oedd yn gallu ymateb) yn teimlo bod yr ysgol yn delio'n dda â bwlio, aflonyddu neu wahaniaethu.
- Teimlai 91% fod yr ysgol yn cynnig ystod o brofiadau dysgu diddorol yn yr ysgol.
- Teimlai 70% fod yr ysgol yn cynnig ystod o brofiadau dysgu diddorol y tu allan i'r ysgol

Parental Survey – feedback

Thank you to all our parents who responded to the recent survey requesting your views on a number of topics in the school, and to all those who also gave their email addresses to arrange follow up discussions.

We received 235 responses and have shared all the information they contained with the governing body. We are pleased to see such positive responses, but have also reflected on some areas that you have identified for us to work on in the new term.

In summary we found that:

- 90% of parents report that their children like school at least 'some of the time', with 63% responding at least 'most of the time'.
- 85% of parents felt that the school helped their children to settle in well when they started.
- 86% felt that their children are safe in school.
- 62% (of those able to respond) felt the school dealt well with bullying, harassment or discrimination.
- 91% felt that the school offers a range of interesting learning experiences in school.
- 70% felt the school offers a range of interesting learning experiences outside of

- Teimlai 70% (o'r rhai a oedd yn gallu ateb) fod eu plentyn yn cael y cymorth sydd ei angen arnynt ar gyfer unrhyw anghenion dysgu ychwanegol a allai fod ganddynt.
- Teimlai 74% fod yr ysgolion yn rhoi'r wybodaeth ddiweddaraf iddynt am gynnydd eu plentyn.
- Teimlai 72% fod yr ysgol yn gofyn eu barn, gyda 71% yn teimlo bod yr ysgol yn ystyried ac yn ymateb i'r adborth hwn.
- Teimlai 74% fod staff yn delio'n briodol â materion a godwyd.
- Adroddodd 80% fod yr ysgol yn rhannu gwybodaeth gyda nhw mewn modd amserol.
- Dywedodd 86% y byddent yn argymhell i'r ysgol i rieni neu ofalwyr eraill.

Mewn ymateb i rywfaint o'r adborth hwn byddwn yn canolbwyntio gwaith ar ein polisi ac arfer gwrth-fwllo y flwyddyn nesaf, ynghyd ag adolygiad o'n gweithdrefnau adrodd a'n strategaethau cyfathrebu.

Diolch i chi am gymryd yr amser i ymateb i'r arolwg – byddwn yn anelu at wneud hwn yn ddigwyddiad blynyddol fel y gallwn adolygu sut mae pethau'n newid wrth symud ymlaen.

- 70% (of those able to answer) felt that their child receives the support they need for any additional learning needs they may have.
- 74% felt that the schools keeps them well informed of their child's progress.
- 72% felt that the school seeks their views, with 71% feeling that the school considers and responds to this feedback.
- 74% felt that staff deal with issues raised appropriately.
- 80% reported that the school shares information with them in a timely fashion.
- 86% said they would recommend to the school to other parents or carers.

In response to some of this feedback we will focus work on our anti-bullying policy and practice next year, along with a review of our reporting procedures and communication strategies.

Thank you for taking the time to respond to the survey – we will aim to make this an annual event so we can review how things change moving forwards.
